 4. heavy rain fog with rain this morning drew a load  
 of rails to the line fence between Lake Saberton & us  
 fixed it up good finished hoeing the potatoes  
 5. got to Cornick's rake got in the hay in the church field  
 put a load for seed in the little mow in the hay m  
 & 1 over the cows that was 4 load in all of that field  
 6. Wm took a load to the River of pickers 15 in all I went  
 to James W. Cornick to see trial of reapers the Holm  
 one laid the sheaf of the best the Champion is the Bondin  
 & easiest managed very heavy rain at night  
 7. Wm drew some old stuff of the road for wood & fixed  
 at the reaper St. Fleacock came from Quetta to the  
 picnic yesterday some rain to day  
 8. Rev. Mr. Dausley preached in the morning & W. Gibson at night  
 9. Bruce W. Hill came with his reaper cut part of the wheat over  
 Wallace & Wm ~~was~~ hauled & fixed or rather worked our  
 10. finished cutting the wheat in the north west field in the  
 forenoon Bruce went home at noon I cut some oats with  
 11. heavy rain all the fore noon I went to Bonaparte at noon  
 to Bonaparte field but that she had got full of water  
 Bruce went with me got 1 bushel of salt 125  
 12. cut with reaper the remainder of the southwest half of the  
 north field Wm helped Bruce at his wheat heavy rain  
 13. heavy rain this forenoon work at the mill 38 cum the  
 afternoon 14<sup>th</sup> Wm helped Bruce at his wheat  
 & mowed oats with the scythe in the south east part  
 of the north field they are very next the ditch  
 15. Rev. Mr. Dausley preached at night fine day  
 16. we turned over the oats they are very wet  
 on the under side Wm W. Hill's mow helped  
 us we got in 5 loads 4 of them out of the S west part & 1  
 out of east part they are what I cut on Saturday
