1. The New Year. Came in very fine, and bright and about noon it turned warm and soft and then began to rain Auntie slept all forenoon. Cousin Jimmie was with us to dinner. 6 P.M. rained heavily Jimmie went to Martintown and I think Murdy went too. Gave him 50cts. 50

2 Wet and slippery

3 Birtie Jimmie & Murdy went to Sandy Ossins to drink tea and spend the evening

4 Far came home tonight. He Jimmie Murdy Birtie & Marion all have had colds. Got 1/2 bush salt 25cts all starch 10. Hatty came she is on her way to the Branch 30

5 High wind not many in church. Jimmie Battanach preached Given went to the front - Auntie is some better of her cough

6 Rained and froze all day. Election of Councillors today Jimmie & Clark bid done the washing Aunt very restless 20

7 Jimmie & Ran went to Monroes Mills got the oatmeal Far walked from Lancaster to attend Sullivan's hosp. all the papers are jubilant over the election of Councillors

8 Cloudy day Jimmie went to Brockville I gave him \$20⁵⁰

9 Womens meeting at Sandy Ossins 20 50

10 Aunt is getting better

11 Very cold Mercury down to 10

12 Sunday so cold, preaching in the Hall 25
