- 20 Lovely day. I was in church and prayer meeting J. W. Calder's wife will be buried tomorrow and Maggie daughter of R. H. McLennan S. B. will be buried on Tuesday.
- 21 Not so bright I washed. Muddy caught perch Jimie left here for Montreal.
- 22 Dragging along Liberal meeting at Alexans.
- 23 Washed bedroom on Kitchen Hairs
- 24 Feet tired got 1/2 gill cod oil 13
- 25 Dusting rags got 1 lb tea at Hillis 45
- 26 1/2 bush salt 20 cts - box blacking 5
- " Jimie came home today from Montreal and went to Alexandria to a ~~con~~ ^{con} meeting. Muddy went for Far
- 27 Rain last night. Not many in church
