Contagion from Bone Tuberculosis.

There can be no doubt but that the danger of contagion from bone tuberculosis is greatly exaggerated. It is not probable that a patient suffering from a tuberculous focus in one of the vertebral bodies is to be regarded a source of contagion if such a focus is in an enclosed or encapsulated stage. There can, therefore, be no danger in the admission of such patients into the wards of a general hospital or convalescents' home. The same is true of tuberculous affection of the osseous system elsewhere.—*Dr. E. H. Bradford.*
