

Mr James Cameron Island 6<sup>th</sup> May 1853  
Drawing the stones from the Tobacco  
Place to the Bank First Ploughing  
Broke the Point Fine Rained  
some Moses Lemay here for Butter  
and Sausage 5 lb of Butter 1 Dollar  
2 Gallons of Sausage 2 Dollars  
Mr Marcell here came for his  
Beardstead at the shanty the  
Grenada came up from Montreal  
to Day 7<sup>th</sup> a Fine Day Seander  
and the 2 Gals went to Lemay  
Brought the stove home  
Gordon and Franky Laplant  
here Quebec at the Fishermen  
Darry Spink came with our  
mail 8 very Fine Ploughing  
the Potato ground taking  
out stones otto Dead  
Yesterday 9<sup>th</sup> Fine Planted  
some Potatoes taking the  
Potatoes out of the cellar  
a nice Lot of them put the  
stove up in the cookhouse  
Put the pig in the Pen

Mr James Cameron Island 10<sup>th</sup> May  
W. Wind Fine Finished planting the  
Potatoes at the house ploughed the  
Garden ploughed the piece below  
the house and taking out stones  
shut in the cows at night took  
some of the Leached ashes out  
of the Leach Barrel put some  
on the Potatoes and some on the  
Hay land our Hay near done  
seizing Fishermens nets and  
Seined at Lancaster Narcisse  
to Lancaster with Fish Garnet  
went up to Day 11<sup>th</sup> Fine Day  
Ascension Day Bodway  
came this morning with a  
Letter from William Morris  
Junior as he is to be Married  
to Miss Plumado Mr Gene  
here Quebec with a Postal  
card to Narcisse Ploughed  
and Planted the Lower  
Piece of Potatoes Rocket  
went Down First Trip  
Fencing Garden Fence Filled  
the Leech with ashes
