- 24 the ground all white this morning worked at the fence got the fence on the corner made & the corner turned up a fine fine day
- 25 worked at the fence along the road running North fine day the plow the I sent for to Brantford came to the Station this morning
- 26 went to youngers this morning on the cars then went Johnny Armstrong & got a double cle made they are well
- 27 went to cantown & heard the Revd Mr Armstrong preach fine day
- 28 got Thomas Williams little waggon & too old bit & brought over to Malberry farm & curriebushes roses & other things & car upon the cars rain most of the day
- 29 worked at the fence & drew some dung ^{the hills}
- X 30 began to plow & plowed a ridge for the gate then plowed on the road North of the 2nd ^{ridge} went to a vessel of Mr. ^{Jacobson}
