26 I & C overhauled 40 rods fence on 11th Con along N West
Corner field which is in Clover Pasture. W. warm clear
looks a little like rain

27 I & C & P B overhauled fence from 11th Con between
big field & N W Corner field down to head of dam
P B is working for Br N. W. fine warm clear

28 I brought home harrows from B D A M
took 11 bus wheat grain to Cedar Grove Mills
P M. started harrow turnip ground below garden
C plowed sod north of grassy ground for potatoes
& hauled few stones off Clark. W. fine

29 I harrowed turnip ground A M. went to Br D's
barrening on his Masham farm P M. C drew
stones off meadow. W. warm A M a little rain
& a very cold blow up P M.

30. I & C finish picking & drawing off stones off
meadow A M. Carried about 50 bags potatoes
out of cellar & pulled weeds out of wheat ~~field~~
opposite Br C's P M. W. pretty cool. Clear ~~at night~~

31 Washed sheep A M. I & C helped J D Plant
Corn P M. W. looked this morning like a little frost last night
Heard today that Pre Silman Meyer of Clinton is Dead
Monday June 1 I & girls & John & Flavors went to meeting
at Medlers Run by Bro Jos Bosky sermon on St John
Part of J & C by Bro H Bosky went to Fairbank after service
& to J Schmans P M. W. fine beautiful
What Monday 2 Cut Reed Potatoes A M. kept holiday
P M. went to Cherry wood & a few minutes to Br B's W. fine

June 3 Drew dung on turnip ground I talked with B C
awhile A M he has been through Pennsylvania Ohio & Michigan
in Company with Bro H Bosky I shared our sheep P M
4 drew dung. W. very close, a little rain P M. W. fine clear
5 C harrowed & furrowed sod north of Grassy ground
for potatoes & I worked in garden A M Planted
potatoes with hoe P M. W. very warm, clear John
Hoover & wife were here at noon

6 Finished planting potatoes A M. C drew dung
I went for Burrows P M Frank is lame on hind leg
W. pretty warm. Close smoky
7 C plowed in turnip ground I spread dung plowed
P M. had Br C's mare with Cent Frank a little
better. is lame in Cord inside hind leg

Monday 8. I took my Mother to J D's this morning
then N & Nancy went to Old Daniel Hoover's W. clear
I both plowed in turnip ground. J Hoover took
away 20 bags potatoes this evening @ 35^{cts} per bag
they are very cheap & plenty this spring. W. clear

10 Took wood to Cliffs at Atton. went to Simon
Hoover's for dinner. W. very close & warm a little
rain P M. C finished plowing & harrowing turnip ground

11 I drew lumber to M Dykes for building a kitchen
C rolled & harrowed turnip ground & drew a few
loads dung into fallow. W. fine clear

12 had W Clod to fill dung, drew on fallow
with 2 teams. W. fine clear

13 Finished drawing dung on fallow Piled a little that was
left in yard W Clod helped. W. fine clear

14 I & little boys fixed some fence & pulled Ridgeon weed
A M Opened & helped store bag a load of potatoes
@ 35^{cts} per bag P M. C is not well went home this
morning. W. very close warm. began to rain slowly

Monday 10. I & Nancy went to meeting at Cedar Grove ^{this evening}
& sermon on St John 8 C by Bro H Bosky. J D's was here P M
W. very warm. not much rain last night. Old Jack Amis
is here. he came last night

16 Chord so shot a young Hawk in his nest in C B's back A M
Finished pulling weeds in wheat & went to J D's for plants P M. W. very close
shower went round south west at noon
