Tue Mar 11<sup>th</sup> a soft day rain in the fore noon, after noon windy and warm, the Snow most gone, not doing much to day.

Wed Mar 12<sup>th</sup> clear and very high wind from the West the river beginning to break up a gain was working about the barn yard

Thu Mar 13<sup>th</sup> clear and pleasant of over head Soft snow under foot. Dr. J. K. Hoames was here last night to see Anne he gives but poor encouragement. I took him back to Thamesville in coming back I lost the buggy seat went back this fore noon to find it but did not get it. did not do much the rest of the day.

Fri Mar 14<sup>th</sup> cloudy and cool, we was sawing and splitting stove wood at the house Anne about the

Sat Mar 15<sup>th</sup> clear and pleasant this fore noon after noon cloudy some snow, we was sawing and splitting stove wood.

Sun Mar 16<sup>th</sup> cloudy and cool, Anne no better had a very bad turn last night. Willard Plummer had a child ~~the~~ Scalt very bad yesterday it died to day.

Mon Mar 17<sup>th</sup> cloudy and soft, some rain, went up to Florence this fore noon for medicin for Anne after noon was cutting and splitting stove wood at the house

Tue Mar 18<sup>th</sup> cloudy and cool, cutting stove wood the fore part of the day, after noon went to Florence for Sap pails Anne was a little better to day.

Wed Mar 19<sup>th</sup> rain most of the day, not doing much to day, Anne not so well to day

Thu Mar 20<sup>th</sup> cloudy and soft some snow, we were cutting stove wood most of the day

Fri Mar 21<sup>st</sup> clear and warm, I tapt a few trees, John and the girls went to Dresden, the roads very bad.

Sat Mar 22<sup>nd</sup> clear fore part of the day latter part cloudy and warm, built the Sap that run yesterday and to day, Sugar'd off a small batch this evening

Sun Mar 23<sup>rd</sup> clear part of the day and warm

Mon Mar 24<sup>th</sup> clear and pleasant, John and I was cutting and splitting stove wood at the house

Tue Mar 25<sup>th</sup> cloudy and soft, rain in the Evening, built the little Sap I gathered yesterday and made molasses of it, we finished cutting and splitting the wood that was drawn up to the house, Joshua Willwood was here this evening, Anne no better as far as we can see

Wed Mar 26<sup>th</sup> cloudy and wet part of the day, cleaned up a few oats to get chopt, not doing much besides, Anne no better
