Blacks to night auditing church books got home half past 2 o'clock I went in cutter.

Gird down in P.M. got at Russells for boots \$1.30 Eaton order 2722 calendar 5 cts 46 cts dry goods Steels. J. Caldwell and I were over at Argo in evening auditing his books drove Bella down home.
