Joseph Taylors & worked at the hat bed fine day
- 9 I worked at the hat bed Grandy ratted the
middle field & part of the church field ^{with} ^{wet}
- 10 heavy rain in the night & most of the day
- 11 sowed seeds in the hat bed every thing is growing
- 12 Grandy & Tennet ^{went} to young this afternoon they
intend to go to Brackville to morrow
- 13 I planted out over 100 strawberys plants that
came from Mr Nickal's at the house
- 14 Rev W. Nickalson preache this morning & Mr Brown at ^{night}
- 15 Ad began to sow at the Road he sowed basket of
wheat & Barley & oats Grandy helped
- 16 Grandy helped Ad out at the road by
ditch or rather to clean out the ^{bed} ditch
- 17 fine shower last night they finished the
ditch in the big field next Cauchane
- 18 Grandy helped Ad at the road they are sowing
- in Lane nearly done.
