- 15 Thursday. I did not go to prayer meeting last night. Murdy & I sowed mangolds beets carrots & turneps. bot beets 5^{cts} 5
 bot 2 lbs butter 35. 1 pan bread 25 40
 Baked, Aunt Mury & Lizzie here today
- 17 Saturday. Stormy wind rain & hail. bought of a woman. a lotion for pimples on face 1 bottle of liquid 25. Far came home 26
- 18 Very fine day. Pa keeps so poorly I do not go out.
- 19 Rain in the night. boys planted some potatoes I whitened the ceiling of the dining room and washed the doors 50
 38
- 20 Rain in morning 9. P. M. rained all day Pa got Willie Gordon to get him 1 qt. gin 1
 got 1 lb figs 10. the water is up on our field 10
 and some of the garden fence fell into the creek Pa was better this morning.
- 21 Pa went to uncle Murdys and remained all day
- 22 I went to see Auntie last night she was poorly Pa went out today too. Jim Bush brought in bush potatoes, 1 bush peas
 boys took the Sifers to Whitfords ~~at Whitfords~~ ^{at Whitfords} out wood
- 23 Pa was out bot 1 lb raisins 10^{cts} look like rain
- 24 Fine day. Pa went with Murdy to Whitfords to weigh some hay
 Bird & Mason went to Lancaster for Far, he did not come up with them. Hatty walked from Branch and is here 25
- 25 A large congregation. Far came home this morning. I did not go to prayer meeting 23
26. Sold Buckwheat got 30 cts. bot 4 lbs rice 20, ^{1/2} gal oil 13 38
 2 doz chickens 10. 2 ducks 10. Murdy went to Lancaster got 1 qt ^{topone} 20
- 27 Very fine day. I got 30 bush oats, 2 bush wheat. Sold yesterday 4^{1/2} bush Buckwheat 2.25 planted onions & beans, fixed strawberries
- 28 Rained all day until evening I went to see Annie
