

November 1892

- 13 I did not go out today. There was no service in our church, our folk went to Watton in morning, to Helybath in afternoon and evening.
- 14 Murchy left for Milleroche today. Wash the flannels, it's thawing.
- 15 Still the warm position was being in London. Eng. today Washed the white clothes today Birdie bot rubbers today Jimmie & Birdie went to Lancaster tonight to the T. Council Had a letter from Rgn.
- 16 When I got up this morning I saw that the clothes line had fallen and the clothes were flopped in the mud. I put four waters on them and left them in three tubs. It is 9.30. P. M. rained all day, and still raining. Jimmie did not go to Lancaster last night. He got 7/6 gall coal oil 9
- 17 Fine day. I washed and hung out the clothes that were soaking. Birdie & I went to Lancaster to see the dentist. he told us to go on Saturday. Paid McNaughton 8.50. for Rans overcoat, 11. to Fraser, for making two suits for Rgn. drove Molly
- 18 Was very fine all forenoon, then began to rain and 9. P. M. still raining. Trimm'd the grape vines in garden and made a little washing. Jimmie put out a few loads of manure on the garden, and sent provender to mill.
- 19 The day was pretty fine for a while Birdie and I went to Lancaster the roads were very bad. Birdie was put under the influence of some drug (chloroform ether & brandy) I think had had 14 teeth extracted. she felt pretty well afterwards. D. McLaughlin
