

July Friday 15 1927

a wet day so we didn't do much but cleanup around and do chores at the barn all day Jean & I cut each other's hair in the morning. I cut the cattle in the pasture for a while after supper.

July Monday 18 1927

Cultivated both pieces of summer fallow in the morning with my team while Dan raked hay. Had turnips till Dan finished cutting the timothy hay then drew in three loads after five o'clock. Jean and I drove up home for a few minutes at night and brought home 170 lbs of oats with us.

Saturday 16

Daddy was muggy morning so he Dan and I both plowed hay ground. Had turnips in afternoon. Dan had to take his operator's exam so had to go to town early. Consequently Jean & I didn't go but went for a swim at dark when I had finished cutting five rounds of hay with the old team.

Tuesday 19

Had turnips for a while after I finished picking 2 1/2 baskets of cherries. Drew in hay all afternoon and got in 7 loads including the one we got after supper. Mrs Webster & sister Gladys came up to spend a couple of days. Warner & Maggie and the girls brought 4 little pigs over for us at night so we didn't get to bed until 10:30.

Sunday 17

Jean and I attended church and heard Mr. Wilson preach a wonderful sermon about children on his last Sunday before his holidays. Cunninghams were here for dinner and supper. Drove Louis two P.O. down and the flats in my buggy after a heavy shower. Had a nice ride to Paris when we saw Aunt Ruby off on the 5:00

Wednesday 20

Raked balance of timothy hay in the morning and finished cutting Clover piece with my team before dinner. Took a load in after supper again which made 9 loads for the day. At night Dan drove Mrs Webster and Gladys to Brentford and Jean and I had a wonderful ride with them even if I was tired.
