<p>Very fine sunny day thawing considerable in sunshine. We spread 5 sleigh loads manure on sand hill to day finished cleaning out pigpen and box stall. Jack M. Stellan here for dinner. Mesdames Pick and Jackson called P.M. also W.H. Barnett and wife. Russells rig up A.M. with set dishes boiler carpet etc.</p>					
6			Wednesday		
2	<p>Mild, cloudy, turned to rain. mizzling rest of day thawing considerable. We spread two sleigh loads manure on sand hill A.M. and hauled 2 loads to ^{sand} pile P.M. Willie took cream to station then went up to allans got bag 15 lbs of rye buckwheat repayment of what we gave him beer.</p>				
7			Thursday		
2	<p>Raining last night - turned frosty day morning cloudy stormy day wind in east in morning turned to west snowing a little. We cleaned out henhouse put door on partition in sheep house etc A.M. P.M. drove May down we went to church. Mr Kay of Tramosa preached from whom do men say that I am & but whom say ye that I am. We gave coll 15 cts May stayed down hill 52 night. Willie dropped some cow P.M. Willie and Bella went down to prayer meeting in Melville at night. Mr Kurrush spoke I got Pundk shod front feet at Gibbons 35 cts stamp etc.</p>
