Tuesday

Fine sunny warm day. We spread 5 loads manure on turnip land to-day thus nearly clearing everything in the manure line. Willie plowed P.M. turnip land I fixed lane N.W. of new road to put calves in stretched welded wire fence to keep calves off weeping trees helped Bella plant tomatoes. Mr Burger called P.M. asking
