Snow and Wind 13th Drove a Load of Wood Went to see if there was a
letter in the R Office none commenced another piece of the Hay on the moor
cut a Waterhole 14th St Valentines Day and Ash Wednesday Went
with the Hide to Mr Streeter left it at Mrs Morris for him
to get Bought of Mr Streeter 1 Pair of Boots 4 Dollars left my
things to get blended Jim Hopkins working at Mr Phillips
15th half stormy some chopping stone Wood Blowing hard
16th mending my Leather mits very stormy with wind
new Loads of Wood and chopped them cut down the
decaying Tree on the Bank before the Door 17th chopping
stone Wood fine day But very windy weather since
the new moon came in windy to night 18th Sunday
a Miss Higgins Birth Day fine day 19th Drove
loads of Wood Went down cut and Drove 2 Loads
for Charlie on the Butternut Island took Charlie up
a tent to Mr Harpers got his measure for a
pair of Pants and Coat a treat at a Summers
Bought of a Summers 3 cents of Tobacco paid this
sent Charlie home got some Butternuts
very unwell Snowing cleaned

20th Fortunate Day Began to Thrash 100 Bushels
Bushels went with it to Mr Harpers 2 Bushels
at 25 cents a Bushel Lashy came Fishing 2 Bushels
Bought of Mr Harpers 1 lb Soap 10 cents 1 lb Tea
Ball of Canneline Wack 8 cent 1 lb Sugar 1/3 1/2 Broom
1/2 Gal Kerosene Oil 1/100 Mr J. Harpers in Montreal
St Matthias Day Lashy left his axe and a spear
coming tomorrow 22nd Washingtons Birth Day Lashy
came to chop I went to Mr Harpers him in Montreal
Bought of a Summers cut Tobacco a Hank of
Thread paid this Water on the ice a fine Day 23rd
very fine Day trying for eels got none chopping stone
seen 4 Ducks for the first going west seen them again
in the evening going east Drove some wood
nose started Bleeding seen Crows for the first
Carp Drawing their House from the Island 24th
Raining and Blowing Lashy grinding the axes 25th Sunday William
Lavelles Wife and Boy and George Bosells wife here Shipping
on the ice 26th Lashy chopping a very cold Day William Lavelle
for a Load of old Wood Christie here sold his spears to me
Thrashing the last of the oats and Fanning 3 Bushels 27th help
Lashy to split his Tree got ready to go to the store did not go
not very good ice slippery Teams Beginning to go on the ice to
from Salmon River one cutter went down and a Team Loader
came up 28th Last Day of the Month Went to Mr Harpers
2 Dollars worth of Flour 1 lb of French Tobacco for Lashy
Andrew John Summers and he is for starting for Cariboo
got a Bad fall on the ice opposite Kenneths hurted my arm
1st of March St Daniels Day The Festival of the
Lashy chopping splitting 3 Logs Looking at Foxes Lashy
for his sleigh and traps Raining Blowing East 7 feet
got 3 and a catfish Raining 3rd Lashy fishing
the Bay got more wet in the forenoon Fine Day Hugh
and I John Angus came me in the Bush Drove some
for troughs cut them yesterday
