 Sunday June 11th Got a Dice Grand Procession Corpus Christi
 and so on High Wind to Day's heavy Rain Thunder and
 lightning the Adolphus went down with a load going to
 Williamstown procession the Picton came out of
 Lancaster whatever she was doing there got some
 papers from Mrs Norman M. Donald yesterday
 12th Hoeng Potatoes Planted some where the corn and Beans
 were taking up the ^{13th Potatoes in the Bush hoed cutting Weeds}
 around the Lower Point and Pitt Point 14th Lashy sitting his
 line here and Pete Bosell here with the Rain and Wind
 gave him some catches for don caught the first Dory
 or Rickrel or Wall eyed Pike 15th Fishing caught 233 Rickrel
 1 chip and the Rest Kereh took home a load of Wood Peal
 some Basswood and Elm Bark Lost our anchor the Rope broke
 A Fortunate Day very warm strawberries ripe 16th Picking
 17th Made Strawberries Preserves Henry Bosell here got
 his spoon I gave him mine to fish Went to Summerstown
 got 2 papers from Dan Thomas as usual supposed
 to Longinal went to George Renshaw got 1 Bushel
 of Potatoes from him George Bosell Little Renaud
 and is on the British America Bought crackers the
 L Renaud a Pleasure Trip from Cornwall went with
 Lashy at night to his line Lashy here all night got 2
 Eels from him Henry got a Lunge about 20lb weight
 sold to John Carey 18th The Memorable Battle of Waterloo
 Went down to Ross Island Killed 3 Black snakes green
 on a crew of French on Christies Island playing the
 fiddle and yelling the Kingston takes 13 minutes from
 the Pitt Point to the Lower end of Butternut Island
 The Magnet takes 12 minutes the Consecan takes 13 the
 Spartan takes 10 minutes the Passport 12 minutes the
 Corinthian takes minutes 19th Went to George Renshaw
 working at the fence got 50 cents from George Working
 on the Roads in Summerstown Rafts a long down

 celebrating for Mr Craig Bought at Falbeau a
 Bottle of Pain Killer as I am awful Bad with
 the Toothache Angus on the Bosure 24th came home
 from Williamstown wind high the Renaud a Pleasure
 trip 25th Sunday Gordon and I went to Mr Hopkins
 with a letter to George Grant took Dinner there Bill
 and Emmanuel there spoke to him about fixing
 my Boat told him I would give him 5 Ton of
 hay for fixing it got 4 Books sicilian Romance, A
 Day Ride, Innocents abroad, Leslie Tyrell, I got from
 Duns Wife 26th Hoeng the Potatoes in the Bush all
 the children in the Bush very warm George Bosell
 here Bargained for his hens took my Bag to bring
 me 2 Dollars worth of flour from Cornwall on
 the Boat 27th Wendy Day 28th Windy 29th Went to
 Summerstown took home my plain and Drawing knife
 from George Renshaw stop at Hamiltons to see if John
 had any Potatoes to sell 30th crossed to Dundee with Thom
 and Peter's pink a all Lennan a Provender of a mag
 got him twice on Jacobs Island Bought on credit 25 Cts
 of flour from a Baker Bought 2 1/2 yds calico spool Soda handker
 Mrs Fitzpatrick young son
