Four oats for Schario who came for it P.M. I skuffed a bag pig feed in morning. Willie took Punch up to Rogersons (Red) at noon. P.M. we finished harvest (except flux) 3 loads oats from No 4 then finished pulling the flock except a small patch with thistles. Jim Mallan and Matt Wilson here P.M. brought 4 sows for 100 lbs (also 1 service) to be taken down to-morrow. We paid N.S. \$4.00 in full to-date being through with him just now Mrs Cook and Elsie called P.M. I sharpened some stakes for fence.

7 fine day sunny. Willie took cream down in morning then took 4 sows to Wilson 6 28 weighed them at scales 720 lbs \$72.00 weighing 8 lbs he got wheat at 70 \$2.00 load put at Ellis 150 lbs lime at Helen 5 cts Schario over in morning got 1st gal of coal oil out of our tanks 8 lbs 20 cts also paid 5 cts for ^{milk} got yesterday. I sharpened stakes. P.M. we hauled stakes to wire fence between No 7 & 71 field I drove them in & stapled them up & killed Willie plowed some in No 6 and crown plow 4 horses when wheelbarrow broke then he plowed with team single plow we brought in wood flux with us nearly all. Mr & Mrs Goss over at night Mrs Goss trying electric battery for his rheumatism.

Rainy all A.M. cloudy all day. I made 4 horse wheelbarrow we made scaffold and put the flux on it. I finished No 7 fence P.M. with stakes. Willie drove May down P.M. she got at Russell's goods \$1.40 chard, 2 pinks 10 cts, at Winks goods \$1.10, at Phillips camp
