 4 60 got it all finished except part of top headland. Rogers brought down some hay in waggon to get out for his show horses. Willie down town P M got at Lewis pair rubber boots 4 50 soles 10 bread 12 ds Mary got meat Shortreads 80 ds goods at 7 & 8 12 5 got from mother for curtains \$5.00

Hard frost last night cloudy day snowing. I finished top head land of No 5 although the ground was frozen then finishing the plowing of No 5. Rogers & Geo down a M helping Willie cut their hay he chopped some horse first P M we plowed in drains No 3 also gathered up scattered tiles tools etc. Willie took Victory to Fords Mary sent letters to C. Young also Thompson re inquiries about lots 13 & 14 St Joe we also wrote a letter to Stephen Wilson

December

Wednesday

1 Fine sunny a M clouded over snowed a lot P M & evening fairly day. Rogers & Geo came a M bagged up their cut hay. We dug out drain and laid it with tiles to drain creek into 6 in tile drain of Black put in at culvert to drain creek so we could deepen it. P M we plowed creek from culvert down to Ford drain outlet and I scraped it out with road scraper. Mary walked down a M to see Miss Ross who came because his father is sick. Willie drove Delta down P M to see him Mary got at Woods stockings & coats she girls and I went up to Sandals at night Willie drove girls up I got ride up with House
