- Sat May ¹⁴ cloudy and cool. rain last night. I cut some of the limbs and brush out of the apple trees
- Sun May ¹⁵ cloudy and cool rain last night
- Mon May ¹⁶ cloudy and cool. I cut the limbs into stove wood that I cut out of the orchard
- Tue May ¹⁷ light clouds and cool I was hoeing the garden. I had a hand shake with John Young he and family are going to Detroit to live
- Wed May ¹⁸ cloudy and light showers. I went to fish but nothing went to Charley Snary's and got my hair cut
- Thu May ¹⁹ cloudy misty rain heavy rain last night. Billon was here most of the day.
- Fri May ²⁰ cloudy misty and misty rain in the fore noon clear this evening heavy rain last night. I was over to Brother John's

Groton May 1904

- Sat May ²¹ fore part of the day clear and hot. middle clear evening cloudy I put a few and cabbage seed in the ground
- Sun May ²² cloudy and warm
- Mon May ²³ light clouds and warm. I Sprinkled the gooseberry and current bushes in the fore noon after noon James McMullen was trimming apple trees
- Tue May ²⁴ clear most of the day and warm McMullen finished trimming the apple trees and I paid him one dollar for trimming. I was cutting the brush.
- Wed May ²⁵ light clouds high wind from South West and hot 93 deg in shade I walked down to the old place in the morning for the Sprinkler the rest of the cutting apple brush
- Thu May ²⁶ fore part of the day clear and hot thunder and heavy shower in the afternoon. I finished cutting limbs and commenced hoeing potatoes
