**Treatment of Shock.**

Authors deprecate wild and indiscriminate use of drugs for post-operative collapse and shock. They, in common with others, agree that the stimulant armamentarium of the surgeon should be: 1. Saline infusion; 2. Morphine; 3. Camphor oil; 4. Adrenalin, of importance in the order maintained. Other drugs, as strychnine, atropine, digitalis, nitroglycerine, brandy and musk are of value notwithstanding.—*Van der Veer; Am. Journ. of Obset.*
