Practical Points in Infant Feeding—No. 1.

Habitual vomiting or regurgitation is almost always due to excess of fat; if not to this, to excess in quantity. For an infant with such symptoms one should never begin with any formula in which the fat is more than twice the proteins, and often equal percentages are better.—*Pediatrics.*
