Wed Feb 18th a cold blustering day the thermometer stood from two above to zero all day. Sarah was over

Thu Feb 19th clear and cold. Sarah was down house work Bilton called this after noon

Tue Feb 24th clear and mild; I was trimming the apple tree tops I cut down for wood

Wed Feb 25th clear and mild. I was trimming apple brush. James Emory died this morning

Thu Feb 26th clear and pleasant. I finished cutting apple brush. Jacob Sprol called

Fri Feb 27th a soft rainy day. James Emory was buried this after noon. I was piling wood in the fore noon. Sarah was here baking and cleaning house

Sat Feb 28th cloudy and wet heavy rain. Last night Bilton Tom Bolton and Dick called
