Rain last night cloudy A.M. cleared off sunny P.M. Willie plowed No 7 4 hours till 11 o'clock when he struck a stone which knocked him off and cracked one of his ribs.

Mary drove him down to Dr Armstrong in P.M. he gave him salve etc Mary got dry goods 63 meat 30 Tomatoes 15[¢] butter 5[¢]

I shingled in A.M. and plowed in Willie's place P.M. Willie paid Lums in full to date \$5.75

Tuesday

Cloudy day rained all P.M. The girls were intending to go to Peter Spork's but went up to Mrs. Sellen's instead got back about 8 o'clock they took Nellie in buggy. We finished plowing No 4 W and harrowed some of it in A.M. - In P.M. fitted the windows in kitchen etc.

Wednesday

Cloudy A.M. some sunshine P.M. showers in evening Willie went downtown in A.M. got at Mannie's glass for kitchen window \$2.40 putty & brush included. sugar at Armstrong's \$1.00 coal oil Revs 65. We shingled kitchen today north side, put trimbles in chimneys painted windows etc.
