John, Scuffled & Father & he hoed mangels, near barn & then he cleaned part of sheep pen. I went to mill for grist, of chop. pd 50¢ also Paid for 100 bu of Oats Chopped \$34<sup>00</sup>, left check at Bank of Commerce, for Jas. L. Simpson Sgt. Caudies, 10¢ Strawberries \$1<sup>25</sup>

We hoed sugar beets & finished sowing turnips

Tuesday, 16<sup>th</sup> Bull  
We finished hoeing beets & started at mangels and also pulled mustard & bars.

Wednesday, 17<sup>th</sup>  
In & Father hoeing mangels & I went to town to meet ~~excess~~ John but he did not come. ret'd Turnip seed 55 35¢ got Flour 60¢
