Renal Insufficiency. Indications of renal insufficiency should be carefully noted following operations on the urinary tract. Accurate measure must be made of the amounts of urine voided and at any sign of failing secretion, fluids should be increased and, if necessary, sparteine, 3 grains, be given every 3 hours. In rare cases of total suppression, decapsulation of the kidneys has been done with relief of the condition.—*Balfour; Mayo Clinic. Med. Record.*
