Fine day cool sunny and cloudy. I worked at L ditch all day got 56 tillis land Willie finished plowing No 2 went over corn and potatoes with weeder helped some with it. I went up to Atchison with Nell in evening Willie cultivated buckwheat land No 7 in P.M.

Tuesday

Frost last night, fine sunny day. We both worked at ditch a.m. got 40 tillis in nearly finished. Willie worked more turnip land P.M. Mary and I went down to Mrs. Mitch. funeral P.M. I got at Merris turnip box 50 cts. Mary got meat 53 cts. I got Russell's 50 bushel feed 10. I had 2 newspapers

Wednesday

Fine day sunny. We cultivated turnip land No 2 buckwheat land No 7. We got 8 rows mangels hoed. Willie at Sam M's. I saw many see get a man.

Thursday

Fine sunny day cloudy at times a few drops rain at noon. very dry weather. We made and sowed 28 more hills turnips a.m. scuffled and thinned mangels P.M. Willie down town at night paid Plowman spreader 1.50

Friday

Warm day sunny a.m. thunder storms passing around P.M. shower here in evening vivid lightning. We hoed mangels and thinned carrots all day. Willie Graham up all day. Willie down town P.M. got bag chop for little pigs 5 cts, rope seed stalks 8 lbs 64. Frotal 1 lb turnip seed 22 below 42. 1 lb salt Ammonia up. Willie took Nell up to Atchison at night. J. formal & Anderson here out of store on way to Jackson goods party
