Steamer Chaffy to St Regis 7th Fine Wind Cool
Fernandez went to Cornwall Began putting
in the Wheat took the Power out of the
Barn Put in 9 Loads to Day Fernandez came
from Cornwall cut some oats Lewis the
Indian here 8th Fine Windy cut the other piece
of Wheat cutting oats put in 3 Loads
of Wheat The 2 Mr Gardner's Fishing
stopt at the Shore to cook their
Dinner Bought Butter and so 25 cents
Jonas Fishing Perch got 26 700 Windy
Ed Douglett on the Pitt Point Day of Eggs
2 lb of Butter a Jolly Time they have Fernandez
crossed to Jacks and came Back not Ready yet Leander
crossed to Summerstown 9th Fine Day gathering
and cooling the oats Ed Renshaw here for
Stanley to go up with him Jonas and
J. Fishing got 23 perch Helping Ed to put in
his Hay Stanley is the Social at the Marsh tonight
a Big Party there 10th Rainy this Morning S E Wind
Mr Webster and Daughter and an Nova Scotia Lady
with them Bought 2 lb of Butter 36 4 Doz of Eggs 48 a fine
old Scotchman from Quebec David Fraser departed
on the 9th 1899

James Cameron Island 11th of August 1899
Cloudy and Fine put in 2 Loads of Wheat that's
14 Loads of Wheat there is a little out dont
count that I drew some coils of hay to put in to
Bottom of the oat-stack Fernandez went
to Cornwall for his Bicycle Jonas and I fishing
got 26 gathered Oats got Papers from Dan
Mr David Fraser departed on the 9th
of August in Montreal a very Fine
young Man Respected by the Whole
Community and in all parts of Country
12th a very very hot sun this Day cloudy
in the Morning E Wind changed to West then
to East Thunder began a Stack of Oats
Mr David Fraser Buried to Day
Fernandez went to his Funeral Jonas
and I Fishing got 35 Buried in Williamstown
a very large Funeral finished the Stack of Oats
13th Fine Windy Leander to Church Fernandez
went to Jacks eat the first Corn to Day
Cool to night 14th Fine very warm commenced
here for the 2 inch auger and chain Raking
some oats and Wheat cut a little in the front
marsh Leander crossed got 3 Kansas papers
2 Glenarrigans and Standard preaching in the
Conseption to night cutting some in the front
marsh all the Wheat in Blackbirds at the
-Corn Bought pan of Bread Sea
