

24) A helped <sup>Nov 1900</sup> Ben finish drain A M  
B & Henry finished fixing fence along  
Pickering Townline that was blown  
down till after 10 am then I went  
to Nick Reson for a road scraper  
he scraped Pickering Townline P.M.  
all the new grade was badly cut up  
with the traction engines it fixed  
it very well A & Henry drove in the  
last of the feed corn along East  
Orchard fence & plowed in the  
drain back of Cider House & cut  
a lot of feed W. a sharp snow East  
wind all day began to snow from  
East after dark. N B young folks  
were here after supper

Monday 25 at home all day then  
A & I went to M B Key to supper  
W. Snow from East last night & A M  
cloudy P.M. a little mistle this evening  
snow did not amount to much, blowed off  
26 I & Henry split wood for Aunt Liza  
Burkholder A.M. A took road scraper  
to Nick Reson P.M. I & Henry  
W. Strong N.E. wind soft drizzle at times

<sup>Nov 1900</sup> 27 I & Henry I saved & split a cord  
of 4 foot wood for Aunt Liza Burkholder  
that we sold to her. A.M. A helped  
Floris at drain Henry plowed a strip  
corn stubble East of Orchard when  
feed corn was then he & I went to  
Cider Grove & to Br. Os W. C. C.  
Strong wind A.M. very fine P.M.  
I & D young folks were here to supper

28 A helped Floris finish drain  
Henry got Mmes. Jim & Mimi chost  
in Whitevale A.M. they chose  
& cut a cedar log in old swamp  
P.M. & took it to Br. Os P.M.  
W. Strong East wind E. Lewis  
& H. H. Albert were here to dinner

29 A & I went to Markham & then  
to Lunenburg paid our taxes \$34.96  
they called at Daniels to ask them to  
help us to kill hogs on Tuesday sunset  
they saw Hermann in Markham & asked  
him too I brought home the lumber  
from Mill then he & Henry made a  
grand base A.M. then A & Henry  
drew gravel on Pickering Townline  
P.M. I drove Ben's team & harness  
& teams they are working to the south  
from where it was put on before
