- It is raining and thawing all day, 2 lbs
- Steak charged at Sandys. To 100 lbs of hen feed at John's 1.45 To 2 loaves 12 1.57
- 28 Turned cold last night. Jimmie went to St Raphael
- 29 Heavy snow storm. Began before 6 AM. at noon still snowing
- 30 It was 29th that Jimmie went to St Raphael and today 30th that it is snowing To 20 bars of Tills soap 100 3 loaves 18 1-18
- 1 box of matches 4
- 31 Mild, and drifting the snow of yesterday

March 6

- 1 Saturday. Cold for 1st April, snow snow all over, not a sign of thawing
- To 1 gall coal oil, at John's 17, 1 can salmon 37
- 3 loaves 18 18
- 2 Cold bright day I went to church, my off It looks and feels more like February than like April 25
- 3 Cold this morning Mercury down to 3 below zero at 5.30 Jimmie went to Glen Roy
- Sent a letter to Agnes
- 4 Cold high wind not thawing, Ann Hall 1/2 day 30
- 5 Soft snow, thawing To 2 loaves 12
- Jimmie got home at 3.30 P M
- 6 Rain yesterday
- 7 Thawing Sent for samples to Estons
- 8 Jimmie went off after Mrs D.D McDonald's, Glen, funeral yesterday and got home this evening To 3 loaves 18 Water running high 5
- 9 Fine day, Sent 25 to church. They say the sap is running very well today
- 10 Jimmie was up at 5 this morning, we had breakfast at 6. He went toward Martintown
- 11 I made a small washing. To 2 loaves, 100 (Big one) 12
- 12 Cleaned the kitchen cupboard, and ironed today
- 13 Not doing much To bread 12, Murdy left for Cornwall in evening, Jack of the lantern, I think was calling him. Looks like snow
- 14 Biddy spent last night in the maple opposite the bedroom window, and Billy is three nights in the pine This is good Friday Mrs Gooin was in last night
- Jimmie got a bad cold on Monday, and has not been out since Wednesday, morning Had letter from Birdie, and one from Mrs J J Grant
