I weighed rest of train & middlings and dropped some pig A.M. P.M. I took another layer of moldy silage off also gathered sticks, stables etc off garden. Mrs Barbour and two children called P.M. Mary went down home for supper. Mr Guss called A.M. to see if we had his logging chain. We got cream charge \$6.16
