- Sat Dec 12<sup>th</sup> Snow thick and fast to one P. M. rain the rest of the day Sarah was here baking and cleaning house
- Sun Dec 13<sup>th</sup> a cold Blue string day.
- Mon Dec 14<sup>th</sup> a cloudy snowing cold day Rose called in a few minutes the fore noon
- Tue Dec 15<sup>th</sup> cloudy and cold. I bought a piece of G. Logan
- Wed Dec 16<sup>th</sup> cloudy part of the day not quite so cold. I was writing away to have some of my papers sent
- Thu Dec 17<sup>th</sup> cloudy and cool. Bolton called this morning Sarah was over this evening Charley brought in my papers

- Fri Dec 18<sup>th</sup> clear most of the day and pleasant winter day. I snared a rabbit last night
- Sat Dec 19<sup>th</sup> cloudy and moderate. Sarah was here cooking and cleaning house. Bolton called awhile this after noon
- Sun Dec 20<sup>th</sup> a stormy day rain in the morning freezing in the evening
- Mon Dec 21<sup>st</sup> cloudy and soft Harey Cragg called in this fore noon. after noon Sarah was in.
- Tue Dec 22<sup>nd</sup> cloudy and cold spitting snow most of the day
- Wed Dec 23<sup>rd</sup> clear cold in the morning moderate in the after noon. Fred was in this fore noon
- Thu Dec 24<sup>th</sup> rain most of the day Sarah and Elva Paul was in a few minutes this fore noon. Thomas Bolton was in a short time in the after noon
- Fri Dec 25<sup>th</sup> clear part of the day and cool this been a lonesome Christmas day no one in all day
