We disked the corn land and turnip land No 2 across I sowed fertilizer ahead of disk on corn land acid phosphate & bone flour mixed from about even with top of No 6 brush down. We used cutaway, 4 horses. Willie drove down town at night Mand in buggy got at Dulakes point 50 cts Ocular 50 cts owed 40 cts from what he got Wed night returned point 90. Ocular 25 paid balance in full 25 cts got at Phillips stamps 10 cts at Brimmer Camp glass 10 cts at Nichols well 15 cts. Mr Barber over at night to see about getting a horse next week. We let cows out to pasture PM find time.
