Saturday toward 1926 7/ 292 84 82401 3295

Much warmer to-day sunny and cloudy a little breezy. We disked the corn land and turned 1 and No 2 furrows I sowed fertilizer ahead of disk on corn land and phosphate & bone flour mixed from about even with top of No 4 bush down. We used cutaway, 4 horses. Willie drove downtown at night and in evening got at Duluth point 50 lbs Cedar 50 lbs owed 400⁰⁰ from what he got Wed night returned point 90. Cedar 25 paid balance on fuel 25⁰⁰ got at Phillips stamps 10⁰⁰ at Swinnum Lamp glass 10⁰⁰ at Nichols and ton 15⁰⁰. Mr Barbour over at night to see about getting a horse next week. We let cows out to pasture P.M. first time.

Cloudy not warm, windy. We rolled and cultivated corn land then harrowed and rolled rows again 35' then sowed 40 rows W.C. 4 D & Golden Glow. 285 Adam Armstrong in afternoon in auto we gave him \$6.00 to enter for field crop competition and \$1.60 for use of his fertilizer truck. Rained a little at night very little growth on trees yet backward water
