- 15. Heavy rain last night, drizzling & showering  
Aunty is putting up a Burn today  
Jimmie went to Martintown to the Log J.  
James.
- 16. Kind of lowery, drizz. Florence Ross, King K.  
came to visit - Marion until Monday  
Our girls, Flo & Jimmie went to a lawn <sup>social</sup>  
at the vic grove. To buy from Beckstead 57
- 17. Fine day, lotted ground
- 18. Another fine day. Mr Burnett - Summerstown  
preached, pretty large congregation  
Annie M. L. (Squire) is visiting at Aunt Kate
- 19. Very fine day. The volunteers left this evening  
for Niagara, to camp. To butter 43.  
I called with Miss Anne McLennan to see  
Mrs Watson. There is a nice new side walk  
of three plank along Warren st, which  
adds to the appearance of the place  
Murdy put Paris green on the potatoes. I saw  
two blossoms on them
- 20. Showery all day, and very high wind
- 21. Murdy left for Glen Robertson this morning  
Mrs Donald Roy & her granddaughter spent most  
of the day there. Annie McLennan (Squire) spent  
the afternoon & took tea. (Yesterday Pa. paid  
the Martintown butcher 57 st, and got a soup paid 57  
20 cts) Birdie is cleaning the sitting room 20
- 22. Looks like rain I put out a large washing  
Paid \$15.50 to McIntosh for insurance 15.50  
sent it by mail to Moore creek
- 23. Murdy got home last night at 10.30. I baked  
and done some ironing Birdie starching  
curtains. A sack of salt at McLennan 30
- 24. Killed a rooster To 1 gall coal oil 24 sugar 25
- 25. I went to hear M. Watson, he had communion  
and the Massons. Marched to Hepzabath 49

- in afternoon. Rev K M Donald preached
- 24. Fine day. Done the washing
- 27. Pa paid the flour, 2.00, and call 30. at McLennan
- .. To sugar 25. Done some weeding in garden 25-
- 28. Began to rain about 5. AM, and rain  
until 5. P. M, it will do a great deal  
of good Libby McLennan came yesterday  
for a visit. Canned two cans of raspberries  
1 of strawberries
- 29. Very fine day. Murdy went North, quite cool, money  
down to 50. at 10.30. P. M
