I took two fowls to church for High Tea 75cts got at Mennis axe handle 20 pane glass for stable & gutter #9 burner lamp 11 brought up furnace pipe mended at Kers on of. Willie finished plowing No 2 in P.M. We all went to High Tea at night expense \$1.00 Mr Robt. Chas lectured Mr Mallon chairman High (Wells) - Synod (Wry) there.

William Mottred in P.M. bought Myrtle \$7.00 got \$1.00 on her Got all the cattle in to-night John Bull, Indel red, (Dutch) Elma Joke jing Isobel in centre stable.
