We Paris greened potatoes with water this AM just finished in time for rain to wash it off again P.M. Willie went down town got at Simmons 1000 lbs pig feed gave cheque on R B \$6.50 got at 7 & 8 groceries 68 cts. he took load wood down home rack on wagon. I hoed in new orchard. Willie down town at night Punk in buggy took 12 doz eggs to 7 & 8 @ 20 cts \$2.40 got groceries \$1.15 got at Shortreebs meat 60 cts arsenate of lead Phillips 25 cts he paid Nickels for binder twine got P.M. 100 lbs \$3.75 woolen 2 cts cheque on R B. It has been impossible to do any haying this week for rain. exceedingly wet weather. We brought up load wood from bush P.M. Saw No 1 jugged last night in box stall & Willie got at Simpsons bread 12 cts.
