 Fine Day Gene went of To night Rained  
 to night 15<sup>th</sup> Mowing in the Upper field  
 opened out all the coils to Dry 16<sup>th</sup>  
 Fine finished the West stack of fine hay  
 Filled the Barn on the sticks shut the  
 Barn Door North and put a good  
 Lot of fine hay on the floor put  
 a Lot in to Day 17<sup>th</sup> Fine W<sup>nd</sup> and putting  
 in from the upper field Mowing  
 gathering The Bohemian Picnick  
 18<sup>th</sup> a very hot Day Leander and Hugh Ann  
 Went to Dundee took 2 Tubs of Butter  
 8 1/2 Doz of Eggs Mowing some in upper field  
 made some coils of hay fixed the  
 Wheel Barrow Hurled My Hand most  
 awful hot Day Narcisse to Montreal  
 Bought of J. J. Flour 200 Wt 4.80 Tin Pans 1.80  
 2 Tubs 60 Tax 5 Scythe and Stone 65 3/4 yds Cotton 2-38  
 Tobacco 20 4 Bars of Soap 20 C Starch 10 Glass 15  
~~Bought to be alone digged 7 Boards~~  
 Pepper 30 1/2 oil cloth 25 2 Pair of  
 Boots Pipes Calico Dress Goods  
 Mary Morris came with them home 15 Bernard  
 13 Day 1870 Mowing very warm Thunder and Rain  
 Lightning Peter Back here from the Rain Mowed  
 some in the Back Place Rained hard to  
 night shot a chicken Hawk

Mr James Currieron Island 20<sup>th</sup> of August 1852  
 Fine Windy E Wind Mrs Scharron came and  
 Joseph Mowing some in the oakfield  
 Leander crossed to Hamiltons for the Papers  
 The girls went to Lewis's Mr Gene came  
 21<sup>st</sup> Fine Gene went to Cornwall Leander  
 the 2 girls and Mary Morris to Dundee  
 22<sup>nd</sup> Fine Mowing in the Back Marsh  
 and the oakfield Leander to Lemays  
 with his gun to Fise 23<sup>rd</sup> Began a Marsh  
 Hay stack Put in all that was in the  
 Upper field the upper field finished  
 the Barn all full cut some in the front  
 marsh Hugh Ann went to Rosses Hall's  
 plenty flying around for Hens Put a  
 Long handle in the 4 prong fork for  
 the stacks Rained Thunder and Lightning to  
 night 24<sup>th</sup> Rained some Fine Mowed some  
 Leander went for his gun 10 cents Got a Mess  
 of Perch from Lemay My Corn is done  
 few flocks of Black Ducks St Bartholomew  
 one of the Lambs killed at the Head of the Island  
 Rained to night hard 25<sup>th</sup> High E Wind Rained  
 hard Pouring all Day water Rained high  
 some foggy with the Rain 26<sup>th</sup> E Wind Fine  
 getting up the sawlog Putting out Manure water  
 high took away one of the shells of the Wharf  
 John Morris and J C here Leander went  
 with them to Hamiltons Island
