Cotton 1 dollar 2 skins 13 third 8 cents Tape 7 cents 2 lamp chimneys 16
4th 11th Charles Rose took up the Heide 45 History credit 2.45
seen James Williams took me to Dover to treat me seen
Rose got a loan of a Bag from Sam. Summers got a Heide
down with John Hammitton took supper at John Hammitton's
left my Flour there all fall about Election Grant P. M. A.
a Fine Day 13th Stormy East Wind went to the Bush for 2 loads
Wood to night the wind changed to west and Blew very fast
at Hilary 14th cut an Elm for saw Logs John Hammitton came
down with my Flour James Grant here to see the Hares
sold them for 6 Dollars to leave 100 lb of Flour at W. Bonds
for me at 2.15 and he is to leave 3.25 at W. Bonds some
Stormy to Day cold to night and Frosty a meeting to night
Summers' Boy Mr. Val. Spouting. Made chairman of
Carlowi Cannon and with every man he done he took the Pipe
out of H. S. M. S. S. Mouth Quite a Route their tonight
if he would follow on much longer he would be pitched out
the Window 15th Saus Grant for the Hares a very Frosty
Day 16th I cropped took a piece of Meat to Hammitton John and
after a Pic to Hookys got an order from Jim Grant on W. Bonds for
Bought Gordons Boots 2nd Needles starch Soda Tobacco Nator
got a paper from John the Wagon spoke to A. S. Baker to settle for
Bag of Flour & got on the 12th John Hammitton talking to me about the star
so bright in the Morning Heard Mrs. Norman McDonald was
Buried to Day Jim Nicholson got a kick from a colt in the Dock
Sunday Cold 18th Cut 2 Elms one of them Logged Election Day Grant
Mr. Val 15th John Hammitton took down the Snow a great Bonfire to night
Summerstown I fired about 18 Volleys to night for Grant

23rd took Black Bark Bought of W. Bonds 2 lb Tea spool
of Thread Paid 8 cents on Letter and Paper to Charles sold
15 lb Sallow got a Letter from Dana that he sent on
the 7th of Nov with 2 Dollars in it cold some 24th Charles
Jephries Birth Day stormy and cold 25th at the Elm saw Logs
cut 2 got it of the Star cutting Wood Drew some from
26th Frosty Windy went to see the Porson 27th
cold and stormy 28th William drawing his mares hay eve
put in the Barn the last of our Mark hay 29th Gordon
went to Hammittons with the saw and the Wool
a Beech Drew some Drags Randolph and Thrashing
Hammittons 30th a Fine Day cutting hay in the Barn
cut some Stone Wood 31st Sunday Jim Hopkins Charlie
George Birch took old Dick home took
some old Weyths and Isaac Elm Bushing the Road
the ice to Lancaster 1st of Feb went to the
Bush chopping Jim Hopkins Bushing the Road
2nd Candlemas Day I went to Summers loan got a

went to see Grant got 3 skins of Yards from

Gordon I went to Charles Rods got 25 lb of
hair got 2 Bushels of Buckwheat from
John Hammitton Willie Rose came down with
Gordon to the head of this land and I met him
