Early Diagnosis of Cancer—No. 6.

Cancer of the lip is of frequent occurrence, and the laity should know that any ulcer of the lip, or of any mucocutaneous borders, that does not heal promptly under treatment, is almost surely malignant, and should be excised. After microscopic diagnosis a more radical operation may be performed if indicated.
