- 5th Finished seeding 10 acres of 130 x 30 lots 9 acres of mixed grain on north hill field & 1 acre Red Lots & 7 acres mixed grain on centre East field. sowed $3\frac{1}{2}$ acres yellow blossom Sweet Clover. $13\frac{1}{2}$ acres Red Clover & timothy.
- Mrs. Ray holds came down to help. Edith house-cleaning.
- Grampa Lee finished trimming & young Orchard.
- 6th Went to ^{Evangelical} meeting at Presbyterian Church, Steffen.
- 7th Went to Dr. McPherson for 3 loads of straw.
- 9th Rev. C. D. Farguharson preached his farewell sermon in St. George, from the text: "I am not ashamed of the Gospel of the Lord."
- 13th Finished drawing off a stone pile on north hill.
- 14th Edith & Leon & I went to Brantford in the afternoon going to Gullens for tea.
- Finished plowing mangal ground.
- 15th Horse came off with 13 little goslings.
- Loop cattle back to the bush (P) and repaired the fence.
- 17th Started to dig post holes for north line fence.
- 19th Cleaned out the pig pen & drew manure to field.
- 20th Went to the Glen to get a load of bats from R. Murray's.
- 21st Went to Empire Day Program at the school in afternoon.
- 22nd Sowed the mangal along the P. McPherson line fence.
- 23rd Went to Anniversary Services at our Church St. George. Pollanna had a little white breifer calf.
