- 6 Thursday prayers in St Andrews a large gathering fine evening
- 7 Prayer meeting in St. A. not so many storming the organ prepared to support a Missionary in China. McCallumby took it up eagerly
- 8 Trying to fix Monday up for to start tonight. Mr Morrison spent the evening here
- 9 5 P.M. Monday will not go until Monday it has grown very stormy
- 10 Cold night day. Prayer meeting St Andrew
- 11 Monday went down this morning
- 12 Marriage at the manse. Robt Grants daughter and one Mc Lennan. both from the S. Prank very wild day
- 13 Towards evening Jimmie saw the snow plough around our part of the village
- 14 Fine day got 1/2 lb Japan tea at Guthrie 45⁰⁰ 22⁰⁰ 1 drawing black tea Rev. had with a note
