18 Ad plow & finish digging in the garden

19 Ad went to the River for a wheel
bushel I went to Gouanaga
for to assist P. Haslep in a liquor case

20 there was twelve cases got home on the Express

Rev W Conley preache this morning M. Michaelson at night

22 Ad plow in the South field & did chow

23 do do I went to Gouanaga on the Express
there was two of the cases a journey till to day

24 got home on the Meed this morning Ad finish
the South field and went to the road to plow

25 Christer young helped me to lay a floor
in the house it is maple inch thick
from 2 to 5 inches in width it is hard case

26 got the floor finished today it is a bad
job the floor is so uneven the lumber is
hard & crossgrained Ad is plowing at the road

27 I fixed up the partitions & other fixing in
the house & got the Cook Stone in
and the other two Stone up

28 the Rev M. Michaelson preache in the morning
and Mr Brown at night

29 I fixed an old Spovel & cleaned out one of the
cross fences in the Southeast field Henry Mc
-Goughlin drew ashe with J. Darlengs team
he drew 3 loads in the afternoon & in the
middle field & 1 to the South field next next
the fall wheat

30 Henry drew 4 loads to the same field

I finish cleaning out the cross fences in the
Southeast field

31 heavy rain the most of the day
had the Cows in the ^{stable} at night
