 Slow job had to put wads before scuffler would get through to long riding
- " 13 Hot. Dry. Stocked up all that is cut. Threshed load of grain up at  
 Hanna. Batcha took away Moffets calf. (took in 1 load from 6)
- " 14 Still Hot and dry. Scuffling in 2 John Helping D & B. Dicka Peering
- " 15 (Sunday) light all day till 5 (Rain) Geo. Mary and Mag to Ch. Green
- " 16 Hot. Grading Road to 15. from 2. Thunderstorm & heavy Rain. Mary, Ann - Eliza
- " 17 Cool and damp. John took 1000 of sheep to Fagus (Horse & Hog) this seasons grain  
 Pretty early. A and J to Fagus got. turn flour. & fixed Pump. finished <sup>20 lbs. 38 lbs.</sup> shuffles  
 white down 30
- " 18 Fine. finished grading. started cutting in 15. Fine crop. finished <sup>white down 30</sup> England, & thinning
- " 19 " finished cutting 15. started in 3. To go. White at night but Mother ill
- " 20 Dark in Load of Timothy. Stocking in 15. Thunder with a dr. cold Rain  
 from the north with some hail. scuffling in 12. finished cutting in 3 all but  
<sup>green bit</sup>
- " 21 Heavy White frost: finished scuffling Turnips (rather late for good planning)  
 finished stocking 15. Drawing in from 6. To 7 reds Flax Pen. Cold night -
- " 22 (Sunday) Another Frost. Ice Hoop. saw. Maggie saw 9 pm. Mary 9 pm. to 10 pm
- " 23 Drawing in 6 & 12. John and Dean at 2. Rev. threshing. Raking 6
- " 24 Hot. John & Dean at 1. (see in morning. took Raking from 12. Packed Pen in 11  
 started to cut oats in 11 (25) coldest since Aug 1900 - 96 to Day then 98
- " 25 Hot. Windy and dry. to Fagus in noon just shed. finished 11. started in 5. signs of Rain
- " 26 Fine. finished cutting in 5. started 7. 2 windy days breaking the grain down  
 D. Michie. threshing 2 hours. A. at Rennie's
- " 27 very fine morning. heavy dew. finished cutting 3 days later than last year  
 Drawing in Oats and Pea (Peas all in. drawing oats)
- " 28 Warm. and threatening rain all day which came at night with a thunder
- " 29 (Sunday) Cool. A. & J. to Ch. Green. had a white frost all the all night
- " 30 slight frost. getting threshing wood. drawing oats. Cool
- " 31 Threatening rain all. sharp shower in afternoon. Choring. bled and  
 out sheep. Pen. Raked 3 and 5. Flax. Hair. see. A. at White's
- Sept 1 Cold raw. wet. raining. Boys hunting up. battle. fore noon. A. Hanna  
 were building wire fence along Orchard. Cool night
- " 2 Frost in morning cool all day. Rennie threshing in forenoon. A.  
 and John there. To funeral of the Late Wm Singer in afternoon  
 A. Mary and Bessie to Fagus to Miss Alaycia's
- " 3 Cool all day till 5 then warm and threatening Rain. go. at. John. Bloke. threshing
