Raining thawing cloudy day. Willie at Allens thrashing all day. I cleaned out stables and chopped some cow and horse the leather belt broke and I had to mend it. The horses went back to No 7 to pasture just at dark we had to hunt them up not knowing whether went

Cloudy morning a snow storm for a little while sunny and cloudy not very frosty. Willie drove down A.M. brought up F.M. & Mary. I fixed sliding handles for pig troughs A.M. Willie fixed ram. P.M. Willie chopped cow & horse. I made some of cover for ram. Willie drove F.M. & M. home again. We got cream cheque \$14 35

Wednesday

Stormy, East wind, ~~snowing~~ and hailing turned to rain in evening everything icy. We finished ram cover A.M. and put it on the ram. P.M. I drove down took cream to Russell's deposited Miss money in R.B., went home, then drove J. Caldwell over to Blacks we audited books (went to prayer meeting between) got supper then got home about 12 exceedingly icy had Pauck. Willie fixed corn coat P.M. W. Flemming got killed with wind mill

Thursday

Stormy frosty snowing I cleaned out henhouse A.M. Willie put glass on storm windows. P.M. I went down got Caldwell & Woden to audit missing books, paid J.L. \$2.50 for Miss Reed & F. Advertiser got at Phillips Rheumatism mixture 35 cts. got letter from Shipman re papers warehouse
