Mon 9 Jimmie went to Cornwall, Jan gave him 6 jars of Orange marmalade, Far sent me xx. of Bell Telephone money, from O'D's

Tues 10 Snow last night - ~~Slept with Jimmie~~ paid him 7-15 cash

Wed 11 Jimmie went in forenoon looking for pells he did not see any. went afternoon get 4 little ones

Thurs 12 Muddy went to Cornwall - 2 loaves 15 - Mrs A C called 15

Frid 13 The ground was covered with snow this at. No Jimmie caught five pike two very big three medium

Sat 14 Milk 60 bread 15 - Coal oil 25. May brought the crock with butter. Crock weighed 12. Butter 28 = 40^{cts} per lb. 11. 20 90

Sun 15 Church 25. Began to take milk from Stuerts 1 qt at night 1 pint in morning 11 20

Mon 16 5 bars soap 25 blue 5 Ann took the washing 8 loaves bread I paid 4 30

Tues 17 Fine weather. Gave Jimmie 10 for butter one 1. 20 = + gill coal oil 35 30

Wed 18 Gordon paid 9⁰⁰ for 3 months rent 10 25

Frid 20 Fine day in evening then rain

Sat 21 Muddy got home at 10. a m. 70 milk 42 42

Sun 22 Bright day Church off 25 25

Mon 23 Far telephoned that he will be down on the 5-P. M train and Alex Mc Lennan from France, he is home to see his brother and sister Jimmie got the Bunny twice weighed 12 10 lbs

Tues 24 Fine day. Far and a Mc Lennan came on the 5 train last night - Alex is big good looking boy weight 208 lbs must be over six feet high. They left on the 8. P. M train. I had John Christie to help get the supper 70 can salmon 30. 2 cans corn 15 each 30 60

Wed 25 Fine bright day. I paid Jimmie on 24 = 2. 62 }
2 loaves 15. John was down brought 1 bag potatoes. and 2 doz eggs for hatching 15

Thurs 26 Drizzling all day Muddy left on Mon day did not get back yet 2 loaves 15 15

Frid 27 Sent an order to Catons for garden seeds 1⁰⁰ for seeds and postage Muddy came home it looks like rain 83

Sat 28 Milk 42 - 4 loaves 30 - Coal oil 25 Jimmie got 1 lb onion sets 25, Sat a black hen on 13 eggs in buggy shed

Sun 29 25 to Church Randolph and John called

Mon 30 Rain Ann took the washing
