Cold, snow flurries. occasional glimpses of sunshine by snow storm at night ground all white. We put up fence gaps AM to shut cattle in No 6 bush headed rails & stakes in waggons. P M Willie finished plowing corn land single furrow. I cleaned granary etc. Willie drove down at night Punch in buggy took to Russell's 11 1/2 doz eggs @ 40 \$4.74 on dp of goods. 2 doz eggs P & L 80 its paid balance of goods got on 10th \$1.20 got at Inulaks point 90 its staples 2 50 Ouder 25 its paid on it \$1.00 meat shortrads 40 its.

Willie drove up to Hannahs AM to see how the cattle were brought mother up with him drove her down evening again Lucy in buggy. I cleaned barn floor etc AM. P M Willie 609 disked small field below new orchard I fixed wire fence S.W. of it. J.C. Richardson walked up P M about J. Hay estate affairs.

Frost last night misty morning, cold, windy, cloudy and sunny clear by night. We spread 19 loads manure on No 2 corn land finishing it second time at 6 loads per acre 8 loads from yard 11 from pile No 2. We also harrowed some of corn & turnip land. Melville hilled up about 5 to 6 and coming to morrow. I sowed some acid phosphate next
