 made it ring for the Revd in the forenoon John yongr  
 & his wife came here on it rest of day & cradles for  
 went to James yongr with John & his wife & large  
 cut the grass and then went to cradles all mowed  
 & cradled what we had then  
 went to canton & hired the Revd Mr Mc Murry  
 9 stacked & drew in all we had out  
 10 helped Will Hayswood to mow David began  
 to crop place the fallow at cradle place <sup>swampy place</sup>  
 11 mowed above 3 mowed beyond <sup>the afternoon</sup> of rain  
 12 went to James Cummins & got 10 bushels of coal  
 paid less 3 1/2 David plowing fine day  
 13 went to Brockville with a tub of butter 10 1/4 lb  
 got 7 1/2 per lb & pay for the tub & per <sup>30<sup>th</sup></sup> rods bought  
 a cradle 50<sup>th</sup> 5.3 & 7<sup>th</sup> that <sup>20<sup>th</sup></sup> day  
 14 finished plowing the cradle place in the forenoon  
 went to Brockville above the river <sup>the afternoon</sup>  
 15 made a fine side in back place & put some there  
 in the house  
 16 began out the Sympat <sup>the night</sup> to breakfast  
 finished & began to cut at the new Barn & near the  
 17 helped the demon went to the funeral of the widow
