- 19 - Shipped 100 R. I. Red eggs to E. Clarkson, Toronto @ \$4.00 per cart.
- 20 - Finished moving Williamsons things up from Blain farm.
- 21 - Went over to Mrs. Progers for tea, to spend the evening with Ada and her ~~the~~ band before they went to their new home.
- 22 - Went to Douglass McCreas sale in the afternoon.
- 23 - Drove to Galt in the afternoon, ordered enough corrugated roofing (7 square) to cover south side of pig-pen, from Mr. L. S. Parry.
