the Water Run at the Ash tree not  
very well to Day 23<sup>rd</sup> Fine W Wind  
Rained Last night Cool to Day put  
the Felt on the granary and Ben the  
2 Boys Stanley and Fernandez went to  
cut stove wood for Kershaws Ducks  
not plenty to Day whipped Corbett  
Heard Sharky's rhypped Day Fine Made  
24<sup>th</sup> Thanks Living Day Fine Made  
a Cedar Raft for Ducks in the Pond  
cut a Log of stove wood of the Soft Maple  
Log set 2 traps for the Mink Cut  
my Hair Snowed to night hard  
25<sup>th</sup> St Catherine Day Fine cold Drifted  
Randolph here 2 of Porter no Boots to Day  
26<sup>th</sup> Fine Gordon came had the Mail  
from Dan Went to Lancaster Farm  
Gordon The Mink got out of the trap  
Bought a coat, sent a Letter  
to the Skin to the Jams
